Due to COVID-19, we held only one drive-thru collection this year. On Saturday, October 26, 2019, HC DrugFree's team of volunteers were busy from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. in the Wilde Lake Village Center parking lot collecting a record-breaking one-day total of more than 1,262 lbs of unwanted and expired prescription and over-the-counter medication. We ran out of bins for the record-breaking collection of sharps (needles, syringes, and EpiPens). County Executive Calvin Ball and members of his staff, Delegate Terri Hill, a Wegman's representative, Howard County Public School System staff, parents, youth, community members, and many others joined our team.
