No need to remove medication or labels from the bottles. If dropping off sharps AND medications, please make sure sharps are not mixed in with your meds. Sharps must be in designated sharps containers or secured in a way that our team can't get pricked.

**REMINDER: We may not be able to return your bags, boxes, or bins as we may have in the past. Please plan accordingly.**

Adults are also encouraged to visit the **Hidden In Plain Sight Walk-Thru Experience**. Tour a simulated bedroom and bathroom designed to reveal where drugs may be hidden in plain sight and learn other potential signs of drug use.

Medications are guarded and transported by the Howard County Police Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).
