
We want your unwanted and expired over-the-counter and prescription medication as well as any sharps.

- □ Inhalers

No need to remove medication or labels from the bottles. If dropping off sharps AND medications, please make sure sharps are not mixed in with your meds. Sharps must be in designated sharps containers or secured in a way that our team can't get pricked.

REMINDER: We may not be able to return your bags, boxes, or bins as we may have in the past. Please plan accordingly.
