#### **FY23 Programs and Events**

- Online Life Skills Training for Middle School Students taught by college students, high school students, and adults were held in the summer of 2022 and spring of 2023
- Online Teen Advisory Council Meetings open to all Howard County high school students were held throughout the school year
- Online Parenting Classes were held in the fall of 2022 and the spring of 2023
- Electronic newsletters, educational programs, and numerous other services were provided throughout the fiscal year as we continued to participate on boards, committees and coalitions throughout the County
- HC DrugFree held two drive-thru Medication and Sharps Collections this year in the Wilde Lake Village Center parking lot. In October 29, 2022, HC DrugFree's volunteer team collected 1,234 lbs. (45 bins) of unwanted or expired prescription and over-thecounter medication. The weight did not include the 23 bins of sharps (needles, syringes, EpiPens, etc.) collected. On Saturday, April 22, 2023, 1,234 lbs. of medication (43 bins) plus 23 bins of sharps were collected.

Many thanks to the Howard County Police Department, the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), the Howard County Health Department, Howard County General Hospital, and many others for partnering with us. A huge thank you to all our youth, adult, and medically-trained adult volunteers!!!
