HoCo Students: Submit your Public Service Announcement (PSA) by April 14!


Join HC DrugFree and the HoCo Student Film Fest for another year of creative filmmaking fun!

Suicide is preventable. Anyone can make a difference.

- Two-day workshop in suicide intervention skills
- · Learn and practice life-saving intervention model
- Widely used by professionals and the general public

Thursday, February 22 - Friday, February 23

The ASIST Training is for individuals who want to feel more comfortable, confident and competent in helping to prevent the immediate risk of suicide. You don't need any prior training to attend ASIST, just a willingness to make a difference.

Participants will learn how to:

- Recognize and assess the risk of suicide
- Use an effective suicide prevention model
- Define and maximize community resources

Medication Safety

In the KNOW... Medication Storage

Do

- √ Speak to your pharmacist about the potential for misusing prescribed meds
- ✓ Store your meds in a cool, dry place
- √ Keep meds in the original container
- √ Store meds in a secure place out of reach of children & pets
- ✓ Properly dispose of unused or expired meds

Don't

- Leave your medication in easily accessible place
- XStore medicine in a locations where the temperature or humidity fluctuates
- XShare prescription medication
- XFlush medication down the toilet or pour it down the drain!
- XSave old medication indefinitely
