FY26 Programs, Events and Partners

- Online Life Skills Training for Middle School Students taught by college students, high school students, and adults were held in the summer of 2025 and spring of 2026.
- Online Teen Advisory Council Meetings open to all Howard County high school students were held throughout the school year.
- Online Parenting Classes were held in the fall of 2025 and the spring of 2026.
- Electronic newsletters, educational programs, and numerous other services were provided throughout the fiscal year as we continued to participate on boards, committees and coalitions throughout the County.
- HC DrugFree held two drive-thru Medication Collections this year in the Wilde Lake Village Center parking lot. On October 25, 2025, HC DrugFree's volunteer team collected 1,125 lbs. of medication (47 bins) of unwanted or expired prescription and over-the-counter medication. On Saturday, April 25, 2026, 1,215.5 lbs. of medication (43 bins) were collected.
